Investigating AI in Adult Education

Over the past six months, we've conducted research into how AI tools can support learning for migrants. Through interviews with teachers and learners, we gathered real insights into both the opportunities and barriers AI presents.

Key Benefits of AI Tools

- ✓ **Personalized Learning:** AI can help tailor content and feedback to each learner's level.
- ✓ **Real-Life Language Practice:** AI helps simulate conversations and boost speaking confidence.
- ✓ **Flexible Access:** Learners can engage anytime, anywhere—ideal for those balancing jobs and family.
- ✓ **Empowering Educators:** Teachers can create relevant, adaptable learning materials.
- ✓ **Inclusive Support:** AI can address diverse needs, including learning difficulties like dyslexia.



Challenges of AI Tools

- ⚡ Digital Literacy Gaps: Both learners and educators need more digital skills training.
- ⚡ Limited Access: Cost of using digital tools as well as connectivity remain barriers for some learners.
- ⚡ Ethical Considerations: Concerns about misinformation, over-reliance, and academic honesty.
- ⚡ Lack of Frameworks: Clear strategies are needed to evaluate AI's real pedagogical value.

We're now working on several key deliverables that will shape how AI can be used in adult migrant education:

AI & Pedagogy Report:

An in-depth report exploring how AI supports the four pedagogical areas of DigCompEdu:
