Upcoming Training!

Early this June from the 6th to the 8th, our partnership will gather together with several invited youth educators in Sofia, Bulgaria, in order to test the upcoming Guidelines for Curricula Implementation and Training, which will detail the integration of the App into regular educational offers. While the App is designed for autonomous use by young people to learn on their own, the guidelines are there to support educators who want to make use of the app to teach young people about climate change.

The Training event will have educators and staff critically pilot the activities proposed for integration and gather feedback for refinement, before the guidelines will be published at the end of summer.
